

# NATURE SCAVENGER HUNT

Directions: Head outdoors and find each item below. Read the clues to help you locate them in nature!



## FEATHER

Look near bird feeders, under trees, or along walking paths.

## SMOOTH STONE

Check along riverbanks, creek beds, or the edges of ponds and lakes.

## ACORN

Search beneath oak trees in parks or wooded areas. Look for their distinctive cap. Squirrels love them too, so follow the squirrels! They are most plentiful in autumn when they fall from branches.

## SPIDER WEB

Look in corners of fences, between bushes, or in tall grass early in the morning. Dew drops make webs easier to spot. Be gentle and do not disturb the spider's home.

## INSECT OR BUG

Flip over rocks or logs carefully to find beetles, ants, or worms. Check flower petals for bees and butterflies. Always put rocks and logs back after looking. Insects are most active on warm, sunny days.

## WILDFLOWER

Look in open meadows, grassy fields, or along roadsides. Wildflowers come in many colors. Notice the shape of the petals and leaves. Try to identify the flower using a field guide or nature app.
